 * **June 24, 10:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., OR 12:30 p.m. ~ Children's Museum of Omaha's Discovery Dome Science Experience**

The Library, with support from 4 R Kids Early Childhood Iowa, is excited to host the Children's Museum of Omaha's Discovery Dome! The Discovery Dome Science Experience features a planetarium dome film and hands-on science activities that bring the film to life. **There will be three sessions offered; registration is required.** There is limited space in the dome, so please register yourself along with the child or children if you feel like they will not be able to sit in dome alone.

***One World, One Sky - 10:30 a.m. OR 11:30 a.m. For Pre-K - 1st grade**

This 23-minute planetarium show follows Sesame Street's Big Bird and Elmo as they explore the night sky with Hu Hu Zhu, a Muppet from Zhime Jie. Together, they take an imaginary trip from Sesame Street to the moon, where they discover how different it is from Earth. The show aims to nurture a child's natural sense of wonder about the night sky.

***The Zula Patrol: Down to Earth - 12:30 p.m. For 1st-5th grade**

This show is about a routine fossil-hunting expedition. During the expedition the Zula Patrol turns up evidence that the Earth's prehistoric past has become an illegal dump site for toxic trash. In their investigation, children will learn about the formation and development of the Earth, and the life forms who call it home.

Join us for a live webinar broadcast from inside North America's largest indoor rainforest at Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo. Learn the structure of this complex ecosystem, how plants and animals survive, and how the rainforest benefits us from thousands of miles away. This program is 'supervised' by either the two-toed sloth or gibbons in the trees behind the camera.

We will have moon/star activities, crafts, and a campfire with s'mores from 7:00-8:30 p.m. Upper Iowa University Astronomy Professor Dr. Jeff Butikofer will help us navigate the night sky with our eyes and through telescopes from 8:30-10:00 p.m. Bring your own telescope if you have one.
